Hand made quilts will be delivered to all of the children and the matron including 500 pairs of shoes and clothes. Dr. Rowley extends a personal invitation to all Kenyans living in the United States to support the orphanage. So far, Dr. Rowley has collected \$6,000.00 US Dollars. An additional \$44,000.00 US dollars is needed to complete the building, water system and solar panels.
