Between 2005 - 2007, \$6,000.00 has been raised. Since our return from Kenya in August, 2007 we've raised an additional \$5,000.00 due to the generous support of RHS Ministries, the George Whitefield Society and Greater Height Missionary Baptist Church, bringing our total to \$11,000.00.
