REQUIREMENTS

The work of the Field Manager consists of three aspects:

- To minister to the orphaned children and children who are gravely impoverished by providing a home like environment. The couple will serve as the head, teaching the children how to properly do their morning chores and evening chores. As well, the couple will conduct evening bible study with the children and bedtime, nurturing rituals.
- To manage and assist the staff at MACHAO. Specifically, to hire and maintain staff to conduct the numerous chores such as crop planting, weeding and harvesting with the field assistant and field tech; other chores like food preparation, cooking, washing dishes, etc.
- To provide material for the monthly updates and annual newsletter to sponsors and friends of The Machao Orphanage Foundation.
